WORKSHOPS FOR REGISTRATION

Note: Do not send kit costs or handout costs in with registration. You will pay the teachers directly in class.

Holly McLay – Saturday 10:00 – 4:00 – Pictorial (Twin Pines)

The pictorial is a scene similar to what can be found throughout Area 11 and around Deerhurst Resort.

Holly has her teaching accreditation with both McGown and OHCG. She is known for her love of painting and dyeing.



Class Cost: \$90.00 + HST

Kit cost: Pattern 16 x 20 on linen \$40.

Most of the material can come from the pupil's stash. Alternative fabrics i.e. variegated yarns can also be used. A variety of material will be available to purchase.

Jane Cuthbert – Saturday 10:00 – 4:00 pm – Rosemaling (Norwegian Folk Art)

This is a mock shaded painting workshop with wool, using swatches, in fine cut.

Jane has been hooking since 1980. She is certified with the OHCG and McGown plus has a Fibre Arts Certificate in rug hooking from St. Lawrence College.



Class cost: \$90.00 + HST

Kit cost: \$75.00 with 18 x 18 pattern on linen and 3-8 value swatches with notes.

Susan Clarke - Saturday 10:00 – 4:00 pm – Spotlight on Geometrics

In this exciting workshop, for 'Immediate' hookers, you will learn about Geometrics through exploring a series of traditional quilt designs. We will discuss colour planning, and explore how light and shadow theory can enhance your rug.

Susan has been hooking for 12 years and received her OHCG certification at the 2019 Annual. Her work is shown at OHCG Annuals where she has won four awards, the latest being the winner of Fine Cut at the 2019 Annual.



Class Cost: \$90.00 + HST

Kit cost: \$70.00 with your choice of quilt design on 18 x 24 linen, student notes and geometric motifs to overlap (optional) and provide that "twist" that makes this rug your own creation. Six designs will be emailed to students to choose from in advance of class.

Janice Daniels – Saturday 10:00 am – 4:00 pm – Tangle Art for Rug Hooking

Tangle Art is a course I developed after taking a Zentangle Course. Zentangle is a therapeutic drawing technique used for those suffering from PTSD, depression, anxiety and stress, just to mention a few. It is different from doodling because there is some thinking that goes into the design. We start the morning by practicing the drawing method coming up with designs that are suitable for rug hooking. By the afternoon most are ready to put a design on backing.

Janice is both an accredited teacher with the OHCG and McGown plus graduated from St Lawrence College Traditional Rug Hooking. She has been rug hooking for over 30 years and enjoys using multiple fibres in rug hooking.



Class Cost: \$90.00 + HST

Kit cost: \$20.00. An 18x18 piece of linen is available for an additional cost of \$15.00. The kit includes: drawing pen, pencil, large paper for design, tracing paper, red dot transfer material, sample design and detailed instructions.

Students need to bring a positive attitude! No hooking supplies are needed in the morning; however, some may wish to start hooking in the afternoon.

Judy Kielczewski – Saturday 10:00 – 4:00 p.m. - Hand Painted Wool and Simple Silhouette

This class will take you under the sky or over the water. The silhouette will only enhance your painted wool and bring your picture to life. The painted wool is the main subject but a silhouette of your granddaughter on a swing or maybe a couple walking hand in hand can add to the imagination of your piece. LOVE WHAT YOU DO; DO WHAT YOU LOVE.

Judy is an OHCG certified teacher who loves all forms of fibre art. Her passion is to create and inspire everyone to find the fun and enjoyment in what they create. Judy's pictorial rug "The Boys" won the pictorial award at the 2019 annual.



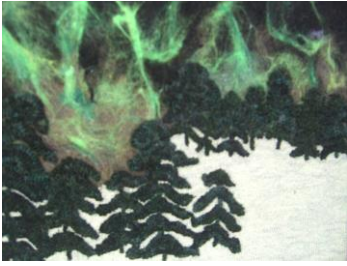
Class Cost: \$90.00 + HST

Kit cost: \$50.00. Students will provide their own hook, hooking frame, scissors and cutter. The project is best in cuts 3-4-5-6. Judy will contact each student prior to the workshop to get their idea about a silhouette to place in their pattern.

Jennifer Curran – Saturday 10 – 1pm plus Sunday 9:30 – 12:30 pm – Against the Sky (Combined Felting and Hooking)

This workshop is held over two days, allowing the wet felting backdrop to dry before hooking on it. Creating the perfect sky backdrop for your silhouette is fun. By using a modified wet felting technique to create the sky and combining it with various hooking techniques, you can create that perfect morning or night sky. The piece we will be creating will be approximately 20 cm by 30 cm (8 x 12) in size.

Jennifer is a certified OHCG teacher and is McGown accredited. Jennifer is the Past President of the OHCG having completed her term as President in 2019.



Class Cost: \$90.00 + HST

There will be a material charge of \$20.00 to cover the cost of handouts, pattern options and miscellaneous supplies. Students are asked to bring a spray water bottle and towel as well as your hooking supplies. Wool batt, backing and hooking materials will be available for purchase.

Marjorie Duizer – Saturday 10:00 – 4:00 p.m. – Combining Weaving and Rug Hooking

Add another dimension to your rug hooking. You will be weaving a small piece either on backing or with a loom that will be available to use. There will be a wide assortment of yarns and other fibres for you to use. You will be creating a one of a kind piece of art. Instructions and suggestions on attaching your weaving to your hooking and finishing methods will be included. After you decide how you are incorporating your weaving, you can design a hooking project to compliment your woven treasure. There will be an assortment of small looms for you to use and information about where you can purchase them.

Marjorie is an OHCG and McGown accredited teacher as well as an Oxford punch needle teacher. She is presently an active member of the Goderich Co-op Gallery. Marjorie has always enjoyed new techniques and is excited to experiment with weaving.



Class Cost: \$90.00 + HST

Kit cost is \$30.00 which includes a small loom (for you to take home), needle, yarn, backing, marker, paper pattern (if you don't wish to design your own) and instruction manual. Please bring along your hooking equipment. There will be wool available to purchase if you wish or you can bring your own.

Karen Kaiser - Saturday 10:00 – 4:00 p.m. – Value of values – Shading made Easy

Want to get the WOW factor? Move your rug from boring to brilliant? Join me for a day of magic. You will learn the technique of hooking values and the use of light that will make your rug get noticed no matter what size you hook. I will also do a virtual dyeing demo on how to dye values.

Karen is an accredited OHCG teacher and is known for her beautiful Oriental rugs that won awards at the 2017 and 2016 annuals. She has always had a passion for drawing, painting and graphic design. Karen headed the OHCG school in Ancaster for three years.

Wendie Scott-Davis – Sunday 9:30 – 12:30 p.m. – Hooking in the Age of Technology

This workshop will take you on a journey through some of the myriad hooking tools on your computer that are waiting for you to use in your rug hooking. We will explore design, colour planning and how to have fun working with your photographs. There will be some excursions to different parts of the virtual world to see what people are working on. Plus see what other resources are just waiting for discovery.

Bring your lap top or your iPad so you can explore on your own device. Please note that not all options are available on all equipment, but you will certainly find out the fun possibilities that are behind your “power” button.

Something about rug hooking captured Wendie’s soul in her very first loop, and continues to romance her some 15 years later. It’s the community. It’s the creativity. It’s the artistic expression. It’s the joy. It’s why she is a passionate hooker and dedicated OHCG certified teacher (since 2006). Her favourite thing to do is explore the many “what if’s” that pop into her head. And she loves to combine the age-old craft of rug hooking with the new-age technology to see where it will take her.

Dawna Matthew - Sunday 9:30 – 12:30 p.m. – Introduction to Oxford Punch Needle

Oxford Punch Needle work has become an increasingly popular craft. If you are interested in trying out this fun and fast technique, here is an opportunity. You will be working with 4 ply rug yarn and punching a simple design of your choice. Everything you need will be supplied in the workshop.

Dawna has been an avid rug hooker since 2012. In the fall of 2018, Dawna was successful in obtaining her certificate as an Oxford Punch Needle Certified Teacher. Dawna has made many punched rug items since being introduced to this technique. She enjoys combining the punch needle method with traditional rug hooking to produce rugs with varying textures and heights. Dawna became a certified Ontario Hooking Craft Guild teacher in May 2019 and will soon hold a certificate in Traditional Fibre Arts from St. Lawrence College in Brockville, Ontario.

Kit cost is \$25.00 that includes a small frame, yarn and use of the punch needle during class.

Tina Cole - Sunday 9:30 – 12:30 p.m. – Sunbeams and Clouds

Please join me in creating radiant sunbeams and clouds. This is beauty in the simplicity of this 10 x 10 rug hooking piece. We will be using variations of minimal colours to create a piece that you will be proud of.

Tina has been rug hooking for 15 years and is an OHCG certified teacher and is working towards her McGowan certification. Tina's business, Tina's Distinctive Colours, features Carolyn Clemems "Jewel Tone" swatches plus 350 colours of dyed wool.

Jayne Nevins - Sunday 9:30 – 12:30 p.m. – Make your own "Sundial" for your Home

This class will have you hooking a clock face and assembling working clock parts onto the pattern. The pattern and clock parts will be included in the kit costs.

Jayne Nevins is a fibre artist and became certified as a rug hooking teacher in Ontario and at McGowan workshops in the States. Jayne loves to attend and teach at workshops throughout Canada and the United States. She enjoys all forms (wide and fine cut) and all aspects (designing & dyeing) of rug hooking.



Class Cost: \$50.00 + HST

Kit is \$30 that includes the pattern and clock parts. Bring your own “Sunny” hooking materials – wool will be available to purchase in the class.

Susan Grant - Sunday 9:30 – 12:30 p.m. – Non traditional shading

A different approach to the shading of flowers. This course will look at shading theory for petals of a flower, but the single petal rose is hooked in a 6-cut using the higgledy piggledy technique and three different coloured swatches. The effect is impressionist in nature. No prior shading experience is necessary.

Susan Grant has taught courses for the Martina Lesar Hooked Rug Studio and for guilds in Ontario. At the 2019 Annual she won the Alternate Fibre and Techniques Award and honourable mention in Wide Cut. At the 2017 OHCG Annual, she won the Wide Cut Award and the Craft Ontario Affiliate Award. In 2018, she became a member of the Celebration Hall of Fame having had six rugs in Celebration.

Kit is \$45.00 that includes the pattern, wool and instruction booklet.

Ruth Emerson - Sunday 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. – Finishing your Rug Hooking into Wall Hangings

With a hands-on example presentation, students will learn how to finish their hooked projects and make them into wall hangings including the use of standard frames, irregular shapes, a soft form of finishing to hang with rods, a hard board back presentation that imitates a poster type hanging plus the proper materials required to finish a piece.

Ruth has been teaching since 1985 and has been a supplier of wool since 1986. She is an a certified OHCG teacher.

Karen Kaiser - Sunday 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. – Kaffe Fassett

In this workshop you will explore the vibrant colours of Kaffe Fassett. Kaffe is one of the most influential living textile artists. You will hook a little piece of a Kaffe design while we explore the history and the world of Kaffe Fassett.
